### Learning Technology Plan

This document summarizes the commitments SVVSD will honor to ensure the highest quality learning opportunities with technology for your child. In addition, it outlines expectations for ways that you, the parent or guardian, can assist us as part of the St. Vrain Valley School District (SVVSD) Learning Technology Plan (LTP).

The equipment referenced in this document is currently an iPad mini, a case, and a charger. These items remain the property of the SVVSD and are issued to your student during the school year as long as you meet the expectations outlined here.

### **Parent/Guardian Addendum to Student Expectations and Commitments:**

#### **SVVSD and School Commitments:**

1. Your school and SVVSD commit to providing online resources, information, and updates about the program on the school's website and at the Family Connections website.
2. Your school and SVVSD will provide information to you about low cost Internet service upon request.
3. The SVVSD will set up restrictions on your student's iPad to limit access to certain apps and content. You can find more about the default restrictions at the Family Connections website. Your school may also set up additional restrictions as needed to assist in managing student use.

#### **Family Expectations:**

1. **The SVVSD Internet filter does not work outside of SVVSD buildings.** You are encouraged to set boundaries, safeguards, and expectations for technology use at home that align with your family values. You can find information on restrictions, family limits, and filtering on the Family Connections website.
2. **You and your student are responsible for the care of this device and any costs for repair or loss** as outlined in the Student Expectations and Commitments. An optional insurance program is available to assist with these costs.
3. **You have the right to monitor your student's use of the device** and know their passwords. Your school can assist or you can find information on the Family Connections website.
4. **You have the right and the ability to set up additional restrictions on your student iPad** beyond what is set by the district. You can find information on how to do so at the Family Connections website.
5. The device provided to your child is intended to be an instructional tool. You should ensure that it is accessible for school work at home, and are encouraged to set healthy time limits for home use.
6. You and your family are encouraged to use the iPad to support your family's learning beyond what is expected by your school. You may install additional apps and content on the iPad for your family's use provided it does not violate our district's Responsible Use Policy (JS, <http://bit.ly/PolicyJ> ) and does not interfere with your student's learning.
