

Student iPad Damage Optional Insurance and Repair Guidelines

What is it?

The iPad Damage Optional Insurance program is designed to help offset the costs of a lost or damaged iPad to families. School Board policy (JQ-R <http://bit.ly/PolicyJ>) requires that a fine be assessed for lost or damaged school property including technology. However, unlike the loss of a sports uniform or damage of a textbook, the costs for an iPad can be greater. Optional insurance is our way of helping offset unforeseen expenses for families. This program is optional, but can provide significant savings in the event of accidental damage or loss.

How much does it cost?

The iPad Damage Insurance Policy premium is an optional, annual, non-refundable \$25/year payment per participant. This fee may be reduced or waived for students eligible for a free or reduced price lunch under the federal poverty income guidelines and homeless students as defined by McKinney-Vento. It is not proratable for partial semesters. Students who newly enroll in the district during the second semester will have the option to participate in that school year’s coverage at the rate of \$12.50. The amount of the premium may change from year to year based on data from the previous year’s damage rates.

How do we opt in?

Through your school, SVVS will offer you the opportunity to participate in insurance coverage by assigning a fee called “1:1 Technology Insurance” in Infinite Campus. To opt in, complete payment of the fee before the enrollment window closes (typically two weeks after your student is issued an iPad.) To opt out, simply disregard the fee - it will be voided at the end of the enrollment window for those who choose not to participate.

If you choose to not participate in this program, you will be responsible for the full cost of replacement or repair as outlined in Board Policy JQ-R.
